Dear Donors:


First of all, please accept my thanks for your generous contribution to the HOST Program. As a result of your help, we have raised over \$3,000 so far and we have been able to award ten monthly payments of \$100 to two students from St. Matthew High School and one student from Cairine Wilson Secondary School.

I met with representatives from both schools and we selected recipients of the first HOST Program awards. The three recipients are described below. In order to protect their identity, their names have been changed and the details of their specific situation are somewhat generalized. All three have been described by their teachers as hard-working students.

- St. Matthew HS student Abby comes from a broken home and has been forced to move a few times and is now living with friends. Despite her difficult circumstances, she is always smiling and very positive. She works very hard and never complains. Abby is independent and is determined to be a success in this world.
- St. Matthew HS student Andrew has had a rough life to date. A broken home with only a disabled parent around. He has worked at odd jobs since a young age just to be able to eat. The school has helped him out from time to time with school expenses and provided lunches when he had no food. Despite his tough life, he is very positive and determined to make a good life for himself.
- Cairine Wilson SS student, Anthony lives with a single parent who is regularly unable to work due to illness. As a volunteer in many school activities, he has demonstrated leadership and organizational skills. One teacher described him as "a true role model" and "a remarkable human being." He is very proud that he has passed each high school course so far and is hoping to attend college after he graduates.

At Christmas and at the end of the year, the students will provide a report on how this assistance has affected them. I am confident that you will see the meaningful impact your contribution has made on them.

While giving out our first three awards is a great first-year accomplishment, it is only the beginning. My goals this year are to increase awareness of the HOST Program and the importance it has in our community, and to raise enough funds to do better next year.
